

Application Instructions

This application may be used for any of our full semester/year or short-course academic programs in Australia and New Zealand. Internship applicants should download an internship application from our web site. If you plan to do an internship in conjunction with a full semester or year program, you must complete both applications.

Application Process

Study Australia has a rolling admissions process, which means you may apply at anytime. You should be notified of acceptance within one to two weeks after submitting this application via mail. If you choose to apply using our Virtual Application Manager, you should be notified within one to two business days after the on-line application is submitted. If your GPA is below the stated university requirement, your acceptance may take longer as we will request additional documents.

To apply to a Study Australia program, please follow the steps below.*

- Step 1:** Complete the Study Australia program application, using the attached application or on-line using the Virtual Application Manager (VAM) at www.study-australia.com. Please review our information packet and web site to determine your preferred host institutions. These selections can be changed, but please nominate at least one university on your application.
- Step 2:** Submit statement of purpose, a 300-500 word essay explaining why you would like to study abroad and why you have chosen the Study Australia program.
- Step 3:** Submit \$30 application fee via check or credit card. This is required for semester/year and short-course programs. Please make checks payable to Study Australia LLC. Credit-card payments may be submitted on our web site or through your Virtual Application.
- Step 4:** Submit a recent photograph with your application. If applying online, your photograph may be uploaded and should not be larger than 200KB.
- Step 5:** Mail official academic transcripts to our US office. We will need an official transcript for each host institution you apply to, along with a copy for our records. If you have attended more than one university or college, you will need to provide official transcripts from those previous institutions.
- Step 6:** If you are a freshman student, community college student or if your current GPA falls below 3.0, you will need to submit two academic recommendations from a professor, academic advisor or teaching assistant. If you are applying via mail, the form can be downloaded from our web site at www.study-australia.com, completed and mailed to our US office by your chosen reference. If you are applying using our Virtual Application Manager, you may email the form directly to your chosen references and they can complete the form electronically. Please note, some host institutions require at least one academic recommendation regardless of your status or GPA. If you apply to one of these institutions, your Study Australia advisor will notify you.
